

THE ASIAN SPA. The Fullerton Hotel, Marina Bay, Singapore

THE RESORT: Situated in the heart of Singapore's arts and financial district, The Fullerton represents the height of understated elegance. Its Doric columns allude to the height of Palladian architecture and reflect the history of the building, which was constructed in 1928 when the area was first gaining its reputation for being the busiest port in the world. The hotel was recently voted the Best Hotel in Asia by the *Condé Nast Traveler Reader's Choice Awards*. **THE SPA:** The Asian Spa draws from the indigenous culture and habitat of Singapore, incorporating ingredients from the Dead Sea, local nuts and flowers, as well as Javanese and Indonesian traditions. In addition to the world-class spa, the hotel boasts an outdoor Olympic-size swimming pool that overlooks the Singapore River. **DON'T MISS:** The Indonesian Heritage package includes a Javanese Lulur, a traditional beauty treatment that uses sweet woods and powdered herbs and spices known for their extensive healing properties, an Indonesian massage and a flower bath. Another popular choice is the Biodroga Baden-Baden Spa Sensation, comprised of a vitamin honey facial, a sugar and macadamia nut oil body scrub, a honey milk body mask and an aroma body massage.
